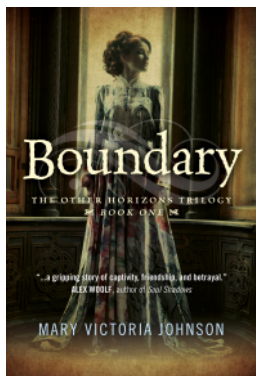
AlphaNumeric

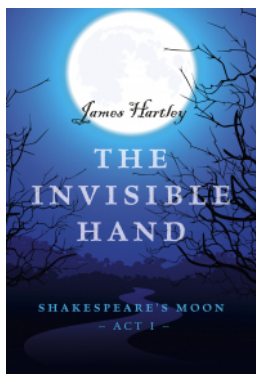
Shanti and the Magic Mandala

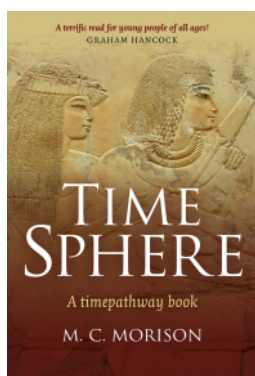

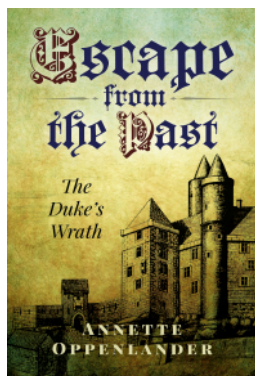
Time Sphere

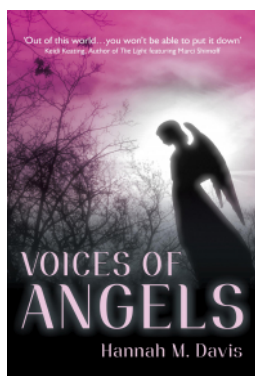

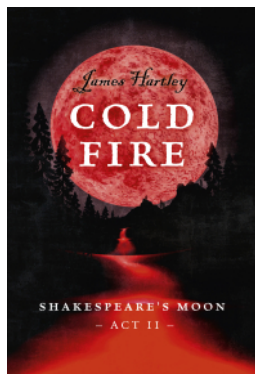
